- The selected scholar(s) must be accepted in or currently attending an accredited institution of higher education.
- The selected scholar(s) will be awarded financial support based on the existing funds available in the scholarship fund at the time of each family reunion.
- The scholarship(s) will be awarded, at an appropriate time, during the family reunion according to the following criteria:
 - Must be an active attendee of the Harrison family reunion
 - Must be entering or attending an institution of higher education. (Including Community College)
 - o Must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
 - o Two letters of recommendation (please feel free to duplicate the form)
 - Sealed and original transcripts from your high school or college.
 - Well-written essay, not to exceed 2-pages doubled spaced typed (handwritten will not be accepted.)
 - Essay theme: "How Has Your Harrison Lineage Impacted You in Moving Forward to Achieve Your Goals?"
 - Completed application must be submitted by Saturday, July 1, 2023 deadline! NO EXCEPTIONS
- Previous applicants who have never received the **Harrison Family Scholarship are** encouraged to reapply.
- Application must be postmarked by July 1, 2023
- Selection Process

The Harrison Family Scholarship committee will conduct a blind evaluation of each applicant using a point system for each portion of the completed application. Serious effort will be made to include as many applicants as possible.
